

## Configuration of Nokia 6630 to Access Email

---

### Note:

It is important to do the following before you proceed to configure your mobile phone to access the Email Client Service.

- a) You need a POP3 enabled email account.
- b) To create a data account called **SunSurf Mobile**. **SunSurf Mobile** allows the phone to access the Internet and Email Client via the M1 network.

### Setting up SunSurf Mobile Data Account:

1. Go to **Main Menu** and select **Tools**.
2. Select **Settings**.
3. Select **Connection**.
4. Select **Access Points**.
5. Press **Option** and select **New Access Point**.
6. Press soft key >
7. Select **Use default settings**.
8. **Connect Name:** SunSurf Mobile
9. **Data bearer:** GPRS
10. **Access point name:** press **Option** and select **Change**. Key in **sunsurf**.
11. **User name:** press **Option** and select **Change**. Key in **65**.
12. **Prompt password:** No
13. **Password:** user123
14. **Authentication:** normal
15. **Homepage:** Leave Blank
16. Press **Back** to save the settings.

### Email Client Set-up steps:

1. Go to **Menu**.
2. Select **Messaging**.
3. Press **Options** and select **Settings**.
4. Select **Email**.
5. Select **Mailboxes**.
6. Press **Options** and select **New mailbox**.
7. Select **Mailbox settings**.
8. Select **Mailbox name** – Create a name for your mailbox. Eg. My Yahoo Mail
9. Scroll and select **Access point in use**.
10. Scroll and select **“SunSurf Mobile”** to be **default access point**.
11. Scroll and select **My e-mail address**.
12. Enter your email address E.g “xxx.yahoo.com.sg”.
13. Scroll and select **Outgoing mail server**.
14. Enter “smtp.miworld.com.sg”.
15. Send message: **Immediately**
16. Scroll and select **User name**.
17. Enter your email login user name.
18. Scroll and select **Password**.
19. Enter your email login password.
20. Scroll and select **Incoming mail server**.
  - For Singnet customer, please enter **pop.singnet.com.sg**
  - For StarHub customer, please enter **pop.starhub.net.sg**
  - For Pacnet customer, please enter **pacific.net.sg**

- For Yahoo Singapore customer, please enter **pop.mail.yahoo.com.sg**
  - For Yahoo UK customer, please **pop.mail.yahoo.com.uk**
21. Scroll and select **Mailbox type**.
  22. Select "**POP3**".
  23. Security(ports): **Off**
  24. Press **Back** to save the settings.
  25. To start accessing your emails, go back to **Messaging**. Select the mailbox that you have created and press **Options**. Select **Connect**.
